Hire a bonded, licensed and insured contractor.

Make sure they have:

- A)Worker's Compensation
- B) Liability Insurance
- C) Bond

Ask and take advantage of any promotions being offered.

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Have a detailed plan and stick to the plan. This may seem obvious but having a detailed plan of your remodeling project before getting started can save you money. Make sure you ask your contractor lots of questions during the planning stages. This can set realistic expectations and avoid additional expenses.

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Have a budget, Knowing your budget and sticking to it is one of the most important parts of your renovation project. The quickest way to blow through your remodeling project is to stray from the original plan, While unexpected plans are a possibility, try to stick to the original plan as much as possible and keep in mind to make room for a 10% contingency.





Choose a company that can help you from start to finish with design and built, especially when planning on a room addition or large project. Avoid miscommunication on your vision.



Plan your lighting carefully. Study your lighting needs. It's more cost effective to introduce lights during a remodel than after. The good news is that CFLs and LEDs have come a long way in the past few years and many are available on dimmers. They let you completely control the light and are well worth the extra dollars. Be aware of natural lighting. Lighting is the key in the overall design. Consult with the contractor.

- B) You can receive a fine. And then have to pay for the permit anyway in addition to the fine.

But on the plus side, permits in some cases can be tax-deductible.

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Time frames and timelines
Make sure your contractor is on time from the
start. That they give you time frames and
timelines they'll follow, to avoid delays and
additional unplanned expenses.







Communication with your contractor is key for a successful remodeling of your home. Make sure you have someone that will answer your questions and concerns; and that will stay in contact with you throughout the process. Always making sure they are upfront with realistic expectations and delivering what they promise.

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When deciding for a contractor ask to speak to past clients, before and after pictures, and video testimonics.

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Make sure the contractor is taking payment in stages, from 10% to 25%.
